



# 2008 AAU Volleyball Classic

- DATES:** Registration: Friday, January 25 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.  
Competition: Saturday, January 26 to Sunday, January 27
- LOCATION:** Orange County Convention Center, Orlando, FL
- AGE DIVISIONS:** Girls Divisions - 10:U, 12:U, 13:U, 14:U, 15:U, 16:U, 17:U and 18:U
- The age determination date is September 1. All participants must meet the age guideline unless they have received an age waiver from the Tournament Director.
- ENTRY FEE:** **\$300.00** per team (non-refundable if the team withdraws after the deadline)
- COMPETITION FORMAT:** Pool play will begin on Saturday, January 27 with AM and PM waves. Single elimination bracket play and finals will take place on Sunday, January 28.
- AAU MEMBERSHIP:** All athletes and coaches must be members of AAU and follow the AAU membership guidelines. AAU membership is \$12 per athlete and \$14 per non-athlete (coach). Club membership is a minimum of \$30. To become members of the AAU, register on-line at [www.aausports.org](http://www.aausports.org).
- ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS:** **Teams must register online at [www.aauvolleyball.org](http://www.aauvolleyball.org).** Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover are accepted. **Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis until all brackets are full.** **This tournament will fill up, so be sure to get your entries in early.**
- Entries will close by **January 3, 2008 or when brackets are full, whichever comes first.** Entries received after brackets are full or after January 3, will be put on a waiting list.
- Team rosters must be completed online by January 11. Changes will be allowed after January 11, but teams must have a roster submitted online by this date.
- Athlete Waiver Forms are not required for this event.
- TEAM ROSTERS:** Team rosters may include up to 14 players and 4 adult staff personnel. Staff personnel can consist of head coach, assistant coach, club director, etc. All players and staff personnel must be current AAU members. Only those participants listed on the roster will receive event credentials.
- OFFICIALS & SCOREKEEPERS:** Each team must provide 1 qualified down referee, 2 lines and 2 scorekeepers for the matches they are assigned to Referee. All scorekeepers must have attended a Scorekeepers Clinic prior to the tournament.

- TEAM CHECK-IN:** Team check-in will be held at the **Orange County Convention Center** on Friday, January 26 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. All teams must have a representative check the team in during this time. At check-in, coaches must verify rosters and will receive athlete and coaches credentials.
- COACHES' MEETING:** There will not be a Coaches' Meeting. The tournament director will be available during check-in hours for questions.
- AWARDS:** Team trophies and individual AAU medals will be awarded to the top teams in each age division.
- COOLERS:** Coolers are not allowed inside the competition area. Teams may leave coolers outside at their own risk.
- NOISEMAKERS:** No noisemakers are allowed.
- SPECTATOR TICKETS:** There will be a spectator admission fee available to purchase onsite at the Orange County Convention on the day of competition. Price to be announced.
